## PIERCE GETS FIRST WIN OF SEASON FRIDAY AT ANDERSON

WILLIAMSTON, S.C. – Friday was a night of firsts for Team Full Throttle NASCAR Driver Development legends car racer Currie Pierce. Competing at South Carolina's Anderson Motor Speedway for the first time in his career, Pierce won the INEX Legends car semi-pro 20-lap feature. The win marked Pierce's first triumph of 2008.

"I guess you could say that the luck is starting to come back to us a bit," Pierce began. "We had a tough start to the season. Things just didn't seem to go our way with different wrecks and problems that put us out of races. We've been working hard and we're real happy to get our first win of the season at Anderson."

Pierce, 16, won the race in dramatic fashion. Running second on the last lap, he made a move to the outside on the back straightaway of Anderson's three-eighths mile oval and made it stick through turns 3 and 4 to cross the line first in class and win the event.

Pierce's Griffin, Ga.-based team made the trek to Georgia's Lanier National Speedway Saturday night for a weekend doubleheader. Starting fourth in Lanier's semi-pro INEX Legends car feature, Pierce drove to a solid third-place finish to follow Friday's win.

"Lanier was good on Saturday night too. It's hard to follow up a win, especially with the tough competition at these tracks. We were happy to get a third and we'll try it again this weekend," Pierce added.

Another doubleheader is on tap for Pierce this weekend. He'll attempt to defend his win this Friday at Anderson before going to Lanier for their Saturday night program.
